Hotel Elliott / * * *

"A massive \$4 million renovation transformed downtown's historic Hotel Elliott into a 32-room jewel. The recent restoration of the 1924 hotel retained the warm mahogany details and original lobby desk but vamped up the old girl with an underground wine bar, a cigar lounge, and a rooftop garden providing panoramic views of the Columbia River and the manicured Victorians peppering the hillside. Typical of early 1900s hotels, the rooms are snug but made cozy with plump duvets and heated bathroom floors.
